Health and Wellness at WSYC

The cold and flu season is here, and the staff and students of Westminster School are working hard to use good hygiene habits!

- Please notify the school office if your child is sick or absent for any reason.
- We will isolate any child who becomes ill at school and call the parents to come and pick him up as soon as possible.
- Keep your child home after receiving a throat culture until you have the results, or antibiotics have been administered for 48 hours.
- If any of the following has occurred during the previous 24 hours, a child should not attend school: fever, vomiting, continuous coughing, heavy/discolored nasal discharge, diagnosis of conjunctivitis.
- If your child is diagnosed with Hand, Foot, and Mouth disease he must stay out of school as long as he has fever and as long as new rash or other symptoms (evolving rash, sores in mouth, diarrhea) develop
